| | | Remind walkers beforehand about the guidelines, including on travel & transport. | None |
| | | Ask walkers to carry a face covering and hand sanitiser in case of incidents | None |
| | | Give clear information about limiting the group size in line with government guidance. | None |
| | | Advise walkers at the start of the walk to maintain physical distancing and to give way on narrow parts of the route. | None |
| | | Advise those who are clinically vulnerable to minimise contact with others on the walk | None |
| | | Ask walkers to avoid touching gates and path/street furniture, where possible | None |
| | | Advise walkers not to share food, drink or equipment such as walking poles | None |
| | | Ensure you have a record of who attended the walk for contact tracing | None |
